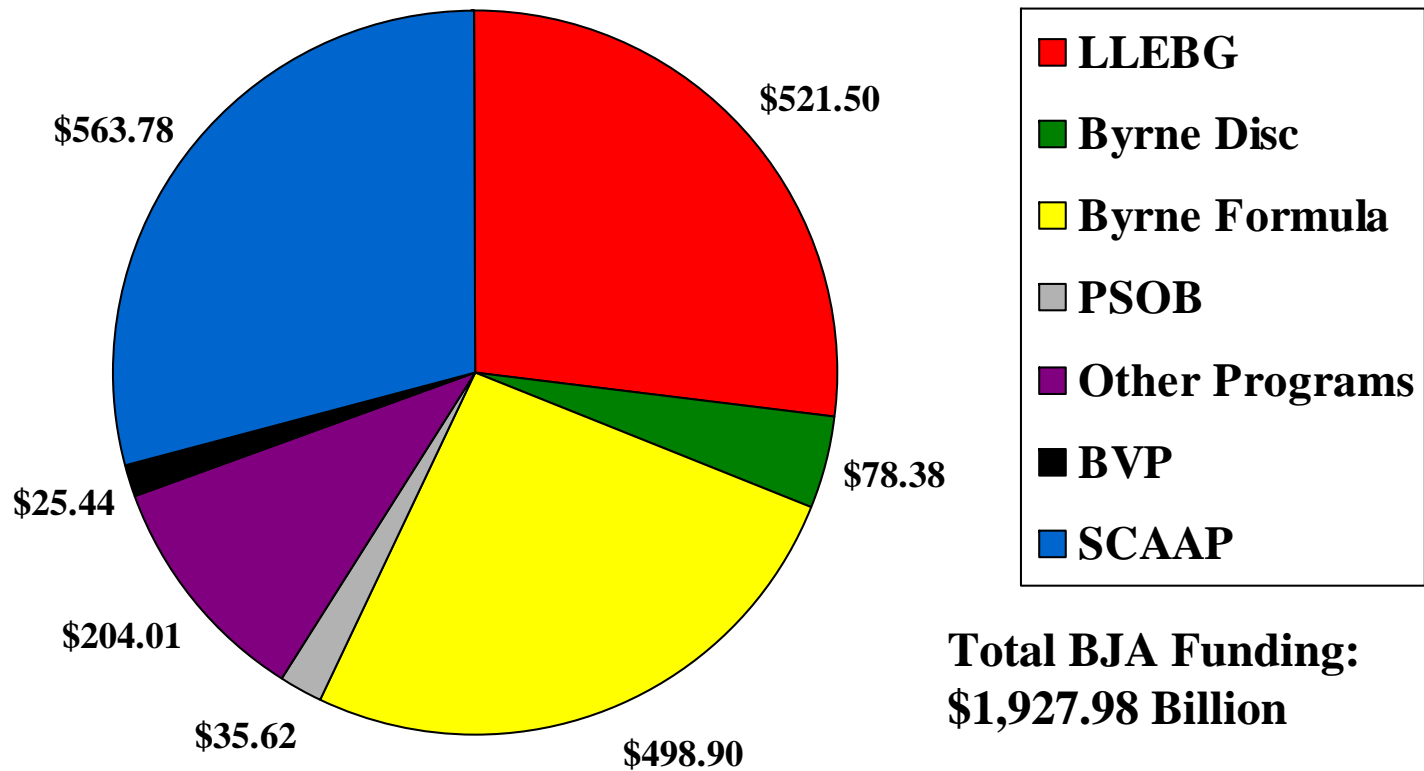

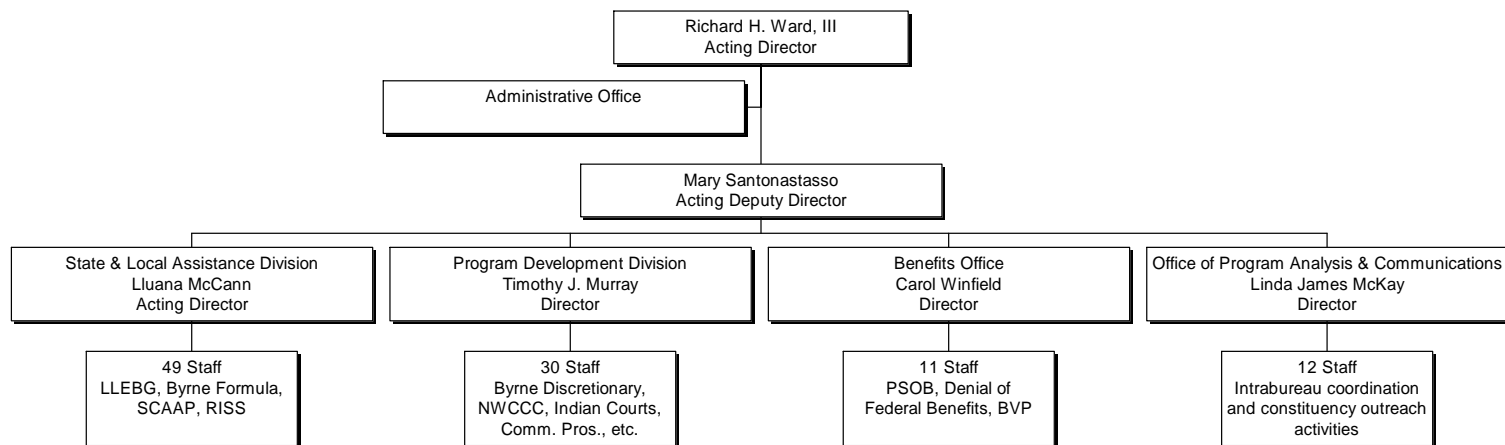
FY 2001 Appropriations (In Millions)

Major Programs

- Local Law Enforcement Block Grants (LLEBG)
 - Over \$393m in FY 2000 to 3,150 grantees
 - States, territories, units of local government, and tribal governments
- State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP)
 - \$585m to 413 jurisdictions
 - States, territories, and units of local government
- Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP)
 - \$25m to over 3,500 jurisdictions for 80,000 vests
 - Public safety officers; judicial, prosecutorial, and correctional personnel



Major Programs

- Public Safety Officers' Benefits (PSOB)
 - \$35.6m, over 280 cases processed annually
 - Federal, state, and local public safety officers and emergency management personnel
- Byrne State & Local Law Enforcement Assistance
 - Formula: \$500m to 50 states, 5 territories, and DC
 - Discretionary: Nearly \$60m and over 500 individual active grants

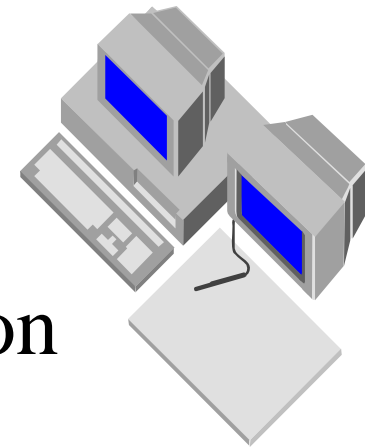
