- In a **February 2002** report in U.S.A. Today, it was estimated that law enforcers were solving approximately **65%** of all violent crimes.

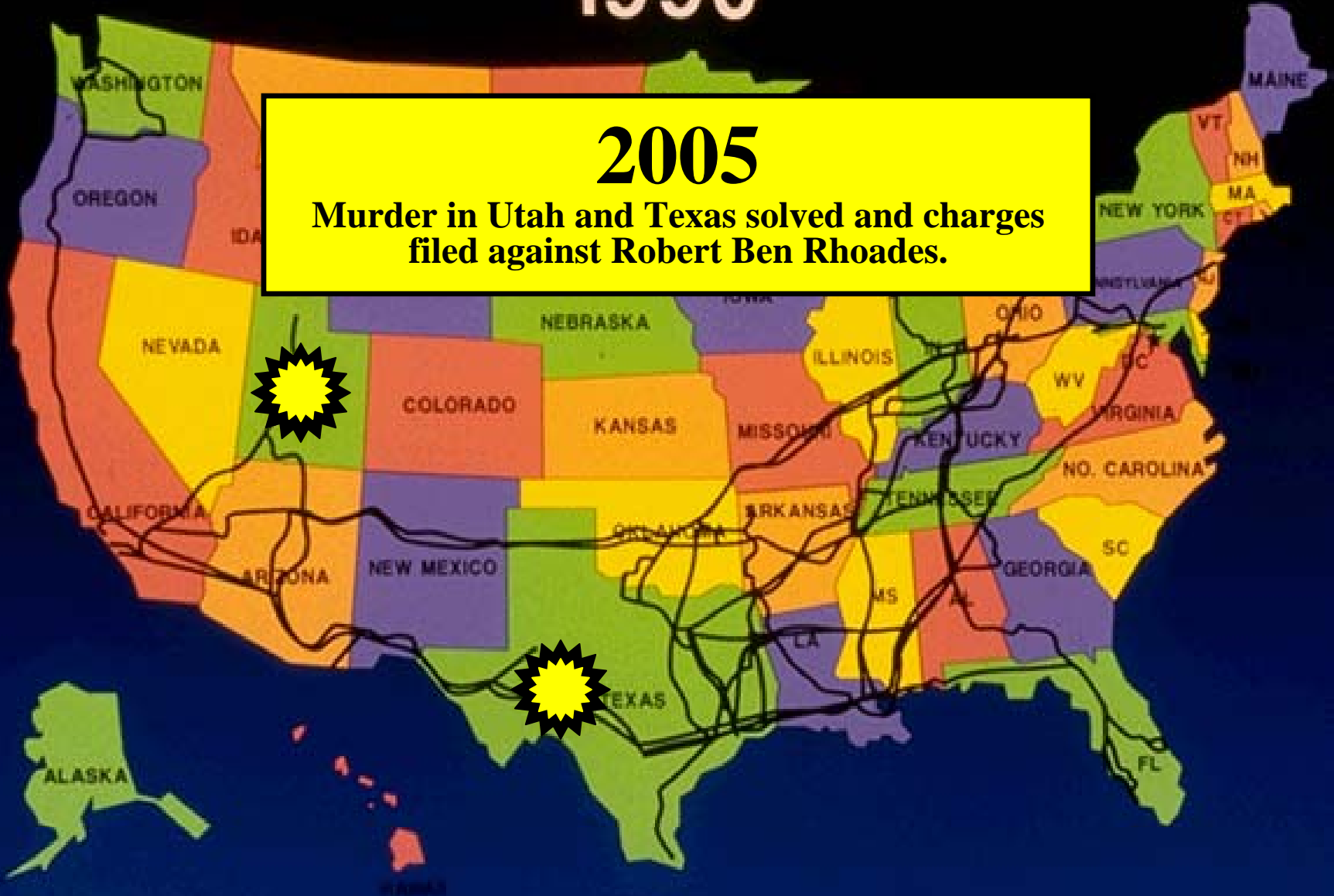

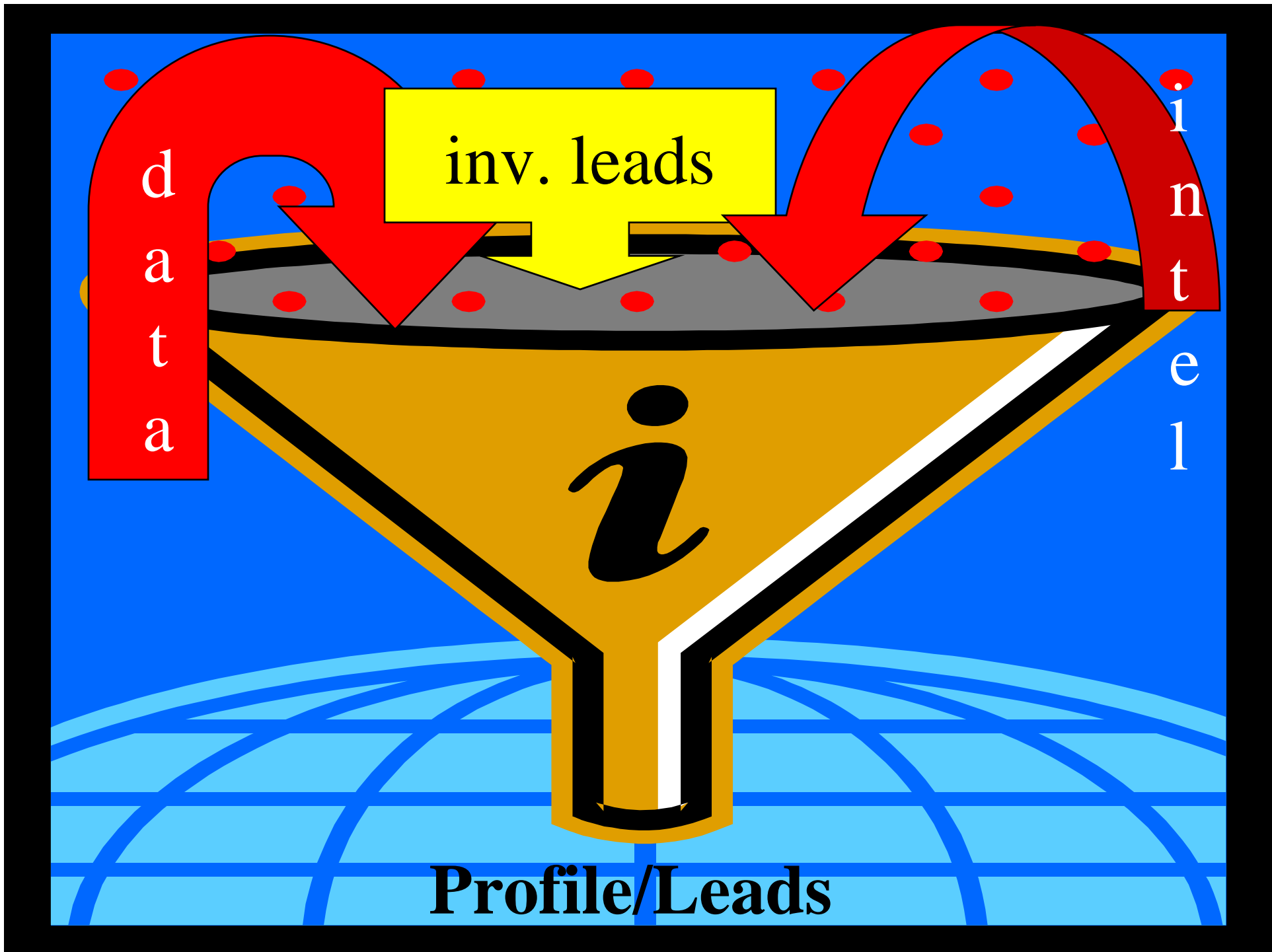

## Sexual Assault Rapist Typology

Typology - Purpose of Assault

### Purpose of Assault

#### Power Reassurance (Wannabe)

The offender is attempting to reassure his masculinity and desirability by exercising power over women. The offender lacks confidence in his ability to interact socially and sexually with women. The offender may be attempting to validate his own self worth through the use of fantasy and forced sexual activity. Although the act of the sexual assault is degrading and emotionally traumatizing to the victim, it is not the offenders conscious desire or intent. This is a common type of offender in stranger assaults.

#### Power Assertive (Macho Man)

The offender is attempting to prove his virility as a "macho man". Many date rapes are included in this category. The offender has no conscious self doubt about his masculinity. He acts and appears as a "man's man". From the offenders perspective he is exercising his right as a male to commit rape. Rape is the method that he expresses his virility and rightful dominance over women.

## Questionnaire (Choose One or Two)

Purpose of Assault **1 - Power Reassurance (Wannabe); 2 - Power Assertive (Macho Man)**

*Comments: Suspect was very focused throughout the assault on achieving sexual satisfaction. Asked the victim if he was hurting her on one occasion but essentially focused efforts on himself.*

Confidence Level **1 - Power Reassurance (Wannabe)**

*Comments: Subject acted scared. Continued to look out the window and continued to tell the victim not to report the crime or there would be trouble.*

Offender's Self Esteem Level **2 - Power Assertive (Macho Man)**

*Comments: Offender didn't seem to have a great deal of self esteem. Continually apologizing for the event and blaming his troubles on his childhood.*

*Comments: Offender was well dressed and smelled clean. Was clean shaven but had most of his face c mask.*

Offender's School Experience **3 - Anger Retaliatory (Commando)**
