Program Narrative Overview: Laptop computers installed in patrol cars for several functions: 1) Integration & access to NCIC and State DMV Databases, 2) Report writing and transmission to police headquarters via wireless network, 3) Access to computer assisted dispatch and records management system, 4) Communication between units and from base station to field units. System now shared by 3 outside municipal police departments for functions 1 & 4.
