The Warwick Police Department established a specialized Computer Forensic Unit tasked with investigating high technology crime. The unit consists of one Supervisor and two Detectives. Members are also assigned to the State of Rhode Island Internet Crime Against Children Task Force (ICAC) Using grant funds, the unit purchased a forensic workstation and a portable forensic network workstation along with software applications that enable the investigators to conduct in-depth computer crime investigations.
